Worshipful Lawrence W Huston Jr., Masonic Journey began when he petitioned the Historic King Solomon Lodge #15, Ft. Leonard Wood, MO of the M.W.P.H.G.L of Missouri in March 1986. He was Initiated Entered Apprentice, Passed to the Degree of Fellow-Craft and Raised to the Sublime Degree of a Master Mason and was member for 26 years. He Demitted to King Solomon Lodge No. 62 MWPHGL of Washington District 9 in Germany in 2013. Brother Huston along with 19 brethren of the MWPHGL of Washington demitted and join MWUGL of Florida Inc. 2015, petition to form a new lodge in Germany and was granted a charter by the MWPGM Anthony T. Stafford 17<sup>th</sup> grand Master of Mason MWUGL of Florida, the lodge was named in his Honor.

The Honorable Joseph A. Walkes Jr. 33° the First President and President Emeritus of the Phylaxis Society wrote and published one of his many Books, a Documentary "The History of King Solomon Lodge # 15" in 1971, and maintain his membership in King Solomon Lodge #15 until his journey ended in this earthly life in 2006. Brother Huston is also an Honorable Brother Member of the Phylaxis Society (MPS)

March 1989, He was elevated to the 32° Degree of a Sublime Prince of the Royal Secret in Queen City Consistory No 109, Jefferson City, MO Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite Freemasonry, Prince Hall Affiliated (P.H.A.), Southern Jurisdiction. Upon his change of address to Hanau, Germany, Brother Huston obtain Associate membership into Prince Hall Military Consistory #304, Southern Jurisdiction and was created a Noble in July 1989 in Aswan Temple No. 115, Ancient Egyptian Arabic Order Nobles of the Mystic Shrine (A.E.A.O.N.M.S.). 1989, he was obligated and became a member of Guiding Star Chapter No. 32, Order of Eastern Star of the Grand High Chapter of Washington and Jurisdiction 1990, he was exalted to the August and Sublime Degree of a Holy Royal Arch Mason of Holy Royal Arch Masons (H.R.A.M.), and received Dispensation M.E.G.H.P. Cleophus D Chapman to open Jimmy Simmons Chapter No 64 in Hanau Germany and was the Chartered Excellent High Priest of the aforementioned Chapter and proceeded to open UD Chapters throughout Western Europe this was but one of the beginnings of organized York Rite Masonry in District 9, of MWPHGL of Washington, he then was created and dubbed into the Magnanimous Degree of Knight Templar, in Andrew Morgan Commandery No. 9, (K.T.) which was done by R.E. Cleophus D Chapman, and R.E. Andrew Morgan.

Also in the year 1993, He demitted into the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry Northern Jurisdiction PHA U.S.A. and was a chartered member of the Eureka Consistory No.113, as a 32°- degree Mason, He had the distinct privilege to confer with other Honorary 33° Degree Masons on the works of the Western European Orient and was nominated by Sovereign Grand Commander Samuel Brogdon Jr., 33° for the Honorary 33° and Last Degree in A.A.S.R. of Freemasonry. In May 1994 he received his coronation to the Honorary 33° Degree as a member of James B Sloan Class at 113th United Supreme Council Annual Session held in Cleveland, OH. As Keeper of the Seal and Archives (KOSA) of his consistory along with dedicated Fraters organized and established the Western Europe Orient under the direction of SGIG Andrew Morgan 33°

He was initiated into Hadassah Court No. 8, Heroines of Jericho District No 9 Western Europe Prince Hall Grand High Court - Heroines of Jericho, State of Washington.

Additionally, Ill Huston has achieved many accolades throughout his military career of 20 years to retire a Non Commission Officer from Military Service in the US Army in 1994; he also served in Operation Desert Storm/Shield and was awarded A Bronze Star for Meritorious Service
